Clothes Moths

Webbing clothes moths were likely introduced into the United States before the 1860's. They often travel with clothing, rugs or other belongings containing wool or other natural animal products. The larval stage alone is responsible for damage to materials. The adult moths lack functional, chewing mouthparts. 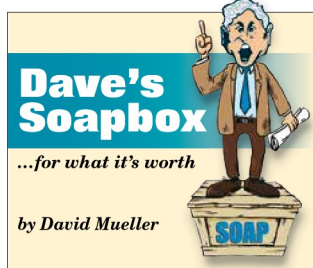
