10 Dermestid Attractant Lures (Food Attractant) for multiple species of carpet beetle and other dermestid larvae and adults. These are best if used in the All Beetle™ Dermestid Beetle Kit IL-2300-10.

Features and Benefits

The Dermestid Attractant Lures (IL-3051-10) feature the Insect Limited's custom attractant for all types of dermestid beetle (carpet beetle, warehouse beetle, odd beetle, hide beetle and larder beetle) larvae and adults.

These lures are made up of a combination of multiple food attractants that have been tested both in the laboratory and in the field on dermestid beetle larvae and adults.

These lures that will attract a multitude of species will remain attractive for 1 year. The larval stages as well as adult male and female carpet beetles are attracted to the lure and are readily stuck in the glue when paired with an appropriate trapping system.

How This Product Can Help You

These Dermestid Beetle Attractant lures pair the science of insect biology to a strongly researched food attractant that was designed specifically to attract the damaging stages of carpet beetles and other dermestid beetles. When paired with a trapping system, the lures do this by:

- Telling you if the moths are present
- Indicating where they are coming from
- Finally telling you whether the control measures (E.g. removal of the infested product, increased sanitation, freezing, etc.) that you have taken are working or not

How to Use This Product

When you open this kit box, you will find 10 Dermestid Attractant Lures. Each food lure is individually packaged to keep them fresh until you are ready to place them into a trap.

When you are ready to use this product, the lures should be removed from their packaging by cutting or tearing the plastic package. The lures should then be placed into the center of the glue surface of sticky traps or in the middle of the glue pad of the All BeetleTM trap.

Although the lures are food-based and non-toxic, avoid direct contact with your skin if possible or simply wash your hands with warm water and soap if contact is made. Dermestid Attractant Lures are non-pesticidal and only act as a beetle attractant.
