Product Description

The Tobacco Moth NoSurvivor™ Kit is designed to attract and trap Tobacco Moth, Ephestia elutella. The kit includes 10 NoSurvivor™ Hanging Traps and 10 pheromone Bullet Lures™ for Tobacco Moths.

Features and Benefits

The Tobacco Moth NoSurvivor™ Kit (IL-180) features Insect Limited's signature pheromone Bullet Lures™ that attract Tobacco Moths, Ephestia elutella with a controlled release of pheromone over 3 months. Male moths of these species are attracted to the lure and are readily stuck in the glue when paired with the NoSurvivor™ trapping system included in this kit. These traps can easily be hung wherever Tobacco Moths are found. Insects that are attracted to the lure are readily stuck in the glue upon entering the trap.

How This Product Can Help You

This Tobacco Moth NoSurvivor™ Kit pairs the science of insect biology to the technology of a trapping system to assist you with the task of monitoring for these pests in your environment. In an Integrated Pest Management program, monitoring can ultimately help you reduce pest numbers. When paired with a trapping system, the lures do this by:

- 1. Telling you if the moths are present
- 2. Indicating where they are coming from
- 3. Finally telling you whether the control measures (E.g. removal of the infested product, increased sanitation, freezing, etc.) that you have taken are working or not.

What to Expect from Your Product Purchase

When you open this kit box, you will find the 10 traps folded and stacked together, along with 10 individually packaged Bullet Lures and an Instruction Sheet of:

- How to place the lure into the trap
- Where to place (hang) the traps
- When to replace the traps.

The traps will need to be first pulled apart and then folded into place by hand, according to the instructions on the trap itself. Each pheromone lure is individually packaged to keep them fresh until you are ready to place them into a trap. When you are ready to use this product, the Bullet Lures should be removed from their packaging and placed on their sides into the center of the bottom sticky area in each trap.

Although the pheromone in the Bullet Lures is non-toxic, avoid direct contact with your skin if possible or simply wash your hands with warm water and soap if contact is made. Pheromone Bullet Lures are non-pesticidal and only act as a moth attractant. If the glue from the trap accidentally gets onto your hands, it is not toxic and can be easily washed off using soap and warm water.

After assembly, the traps are then ready to be placed out in areas where moths are being seen. Trap placement begins your monitoring program for male moths that are attracted to the female sex pheromone in the Bullet Lures. These traps will give you the information that you need to reduce or remove your moth issue.
